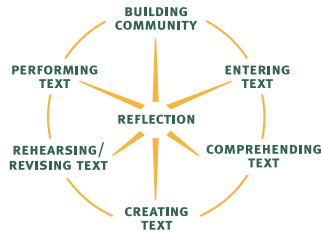

Participants in the ArtsLiteracy Project’s Summer Workshop Week will participate in a range of new activities representing every portion of the Performance Cycle, the ArtsLiteracy Project’s instructional framework. In addition, teachers have the unique opportunity to observe ArtsLiteracy classrooms at Brown Summer High School.



The Performance Cycle provides a structure for teaching challenging texts in elementary and secondary school classrooms using performance in rigorous and creative ways. The cycle guides all of the literacy curriculum work in our “Page to the Stage” classes at Brown Summer High School, in artist/teacher school year partnerships, and in all teacher and artist professional development workshops.

Workshops will also explore designing ArtsLiteracy curricula for school-age youth.


